It was decided that a 1000-gallon tank would give them what they would need.

**New Business**


First topic discussed was if the village wanted to take over the Birthday sign from the Circle Club. It was decided that we would get Craig to take it and bring it over to the Dr Roddy Center. Some discussion followed on the crosswalk with flashing light across from the Landing Shops. The CAO advised that the applications have been submitted to ACOA and Provincial Government to cover the cost of the Marina Business Plan proposal that will be done by MRSB. With regards to garbage pickup, it was decided to call and get prices from Label and GFL and start biweekly pickups at the Complex.

There is a Recreation Grant that is available and has been applied for in the past by the rink but with the way the winters have been lately it is doubtful if there will be ice in the rink again this winter. Discussion followed as to what would be the best use of this funding.

The CAO advised that Sara Deveau had taken many pictures of St Peter's and they have been submitted to Jay so they can be uploaded to our webpage. Council discussed and came up with ideas of what should be on our page such as: Landing, Complex, Courthouse, Sunsets over the Bay, walking bridge, bike trail, Ricks, Fryers Hut, Climate Change Center and the drone pic of the Campground.

Council was advised by the Mayor that Craig Campbell has accepted the full time position of Maintenance Supervisor and will start the job on June 26.
