#### Rentals at the Dr. Roddie Centre

Just wanted to update everyone about wakes and receptions at the Dr. Roddie Community Centre. In 2020, the municipality of St. Peter's Bay entered into a rental agreement with the Province of PEI for a Seniors Day Program that is offered on Mondays and Wednesdays every week. This was passed by Council; what this means is that on Mondays and Wednesdays the Dr. Roddie Community Centre cannot be used for a wake or reception. On Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Tuesday a wake can be held as well as a reception after the funeral. If a wake is held at the Dr. Roddie Community Centre on Sunday, and the funeral is at 10 am on Monday, then the reception after the funeral would be held at the St. Peter's Bay Circle Club. We thank you for understanding that we have to honor our rental agreement with our seniors.

The Community Office is open to the public, but we ask that donations for the Community Cupboard be made at the specified time for drop-offs which will now be on Tuesdays(s) from 2-5 pm. It is lovely to see so many friendly faces and generous donations, but it leads to longer days in the office trying to catch up on office work that doesn't get completed due to time spent away from the desk.

If you are making a sewer payment at the office, please do so by putting it in the drop box outside our door and it will be received as we check our lock box daily.

We work hard to keep everything running smoothly and effectively in the office but with limited office hours we need to utilize our time as efficiently as possible. We do hope you understand.

### Parks Canada — January 2024



Happy New year from Parks Canada! From all of us at PEI National Park, we hope you have a happy and healthy 2024! Here are a few updates from Parks Canada regarding winter in the park.

#### Off-season access

All Parks Canada visitor facilities, including washrooms, have closed for the season. Visitors are still welcome to us the PEI National Park trail system and access the beaches during the winter months. Visitors are reminded that they are responsible for their own safety and to plan ahead.

Parks Canada plows the Gulf Shore Parkway between Cavendish to North Rustico and Brackley to Dalvay, as well as several parking areas in the national park including the Greenwich Interpretation Centre, Cavendish Beach, Brackley Beach, Dalvay Beach, Bubbling Springs/Farmlands Trailhead, Ross Lane Beach, Shaws Beach, and North Rustico Beach (paved section). Please plan your trip accordingly.

Trails will not be groomed or maintained throughout winter. All off-season guests should take the necessary precautions to protect themselves from harsh weather and potential natural hazards found in the park, as emergency services are limited during the winter months. Some areas in PEI National Park experience lapses in cell service from time to time, rendering them unreliable in emergency situations. Remember to let someone know where you are going and your anticipated return time before you set out on an adventure.

#### Protecting the dunes

Dune closures remain in effect throughout the off-season. It is prohibited to walk on any part of the sand dunes as they remain fragile year-round. We all have an important part to play in protecting these important wildlife habitats and unique geographical features. Thank you to all who continue to protect these treasured areas

#### Dogs and domestic animals

Dogs and other domestic animals must remain on-leash at all times anywhere in PEI National Park—whether on trails or on the beach. Pet owners are reminded that they are always required to clean up after their pets. During the off-season, some waste receptacles have been removed and owners must be prepared to pack out any waste bags from their visit.

#### Other PEI National Park news

Reservations for the 2024 PEI National Park campground will launch on February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 8am ATL. Reservations can be made by calling the Parks Canada Reservation service at 1-877-737-3783, or online at reservation.pc.gc.ca.

The Health Equipment Loan Program (HELP) of the Canadian Red Cross allows people to return home from hospital earlier or recover more safely at home from serious injury, illness or surgery, and gives independence and dignity to those in palliative care.

Individuals can receive short-term loans of mobility and safety devices such as wheelchairs, walkers, bath seats, benches, commodes and toilet seats, crutches and canes, bed handles and other durable medical equipment.

There is no charge for loans but a written referral outlining what items are needed is required from a doctor or other medical professional.

#### This Month's Safety Tips

- When the winter air is crisp and the ground is covered with snow, there's nothing like taking a walk to enjoy the beauty of the season and walking is one of the best ways to keep fit. Choose a good pair of winter boots. For warmth and stability look for these features: well-insulated, waterproof, thick non-slip tread sole made of natural rubber, wide low heels, light-weight. Help other road users see you by wearing bright colors or adding reflective material to clothing.
- Plan ahead for poor weather and try to have at least your gas tank half full. The extra fuel can help reduce moisture problems and give weight to the vehicle. Have a winter survival kit in your vehicle so you are prepared for an emergency. A basic kit should include the following items:

  1) non-perishable food and water 2)wind-up flashlight 3) small shovel, snowbrush and windshield scrapper 4) First Aid kit 5) blanket 6)roadmaps (in case you can't get a signal) and extra clothes, etc.
- A Fresh snowfall can cover up hazards such as icy patches or uneven surfaces. Ice is most slippery at around plus 1 or 2 degrees Celsius due to the film of water that forms on the surface. Areas in shadows still can have a layer of ice despite temperatures being above 0 degrees Celsius. Use caution when walking around vehicles as tire marks can pack the snow and make the surface slippery.
