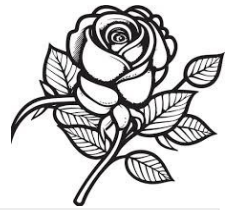

**Day Use Areas Opening for the Season:**

Beginning in mid May, many day use areas and beach access points will re-open in PEI National Park. This includes certain parking lots and washroom facilities and well as garbage collection and janitorial services. We look forward to welcoming locals and visitors for another season of memory making.

**Early Bird Passes on Sale:**

Entry fees will apply in PEI National Park beginning June 5<sup>th</sup>. Parks Canada is offering season entry passes at discounted rates prior to the beginning of the 2024 operating season. Season passes offer unlimited access to the park in 2024, including beaches, trails, visitor services, and facilities.

Season entry passes for PEI National Park are available at the following locations:

1. Online at [www.parksorders.ca](http://www.parksorders.ca).
2. In person at Ardgowan National Historic Site in Charlottetown, Monday to Friday 8:30am-4:30pm.
3. In person at Green Gables Heritage Place, 7 days a week from 9:00am-5:00pm, beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. In person at the Greenwich Interpretive Centre beginning June 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Beach Domestic Animal Ban in Effect:**

To provide a safe environment for visitors and to protect wildlife and their habitats, domestic animals are not permitted on the beaches of PEI National Park from April 1 to October 15. The presence of dogs and other domestic animals on beaches can cause disturbance to wildlife, including the endangered Piping Plover. The minimum fine for a violation is \$100.

Dogs are permitted in all other outdoor areas of the park. Visitors are reminded that all pets must be on a leash at all times (maximum length 3 metres) and owners are required to clean up after their pet.

**Protecting the Dunes:**

Full dune closures are in effect throughout PEI National Park. It is prohibited to walk on any part of the sand dunes as they remain fragile year-round. We all have a key role to play in protecting these important wildlife habitats and unique natural features. For the safety and health of these unique natural wonders, please stay off the dunes. The minimum fine for a violation of dune closures is \$150.

**Piping Plovers and Other Species at Risk:**

Endangered Piping Plovers are returning to PEI. They nest on sandy beaches and use cobble and broken seashells to help disguise the location of their eggs. Ensuring an undisturbed nesting area goes a long way to fostering a successful recovery for this species at risk.

If you find yourself on a beach where Piping Plovers are nesting, you can help by respecting closed areas. If you think you may have found an unprotected nest, report it to Parks Canada at 902-672-6350.

Keep and eye out for some of these other species at risk in PEI National Park this spring:

1. Bank Swallows
2. Olive-sided Flycatchers
3. Canada Warblers
4. Eastern Wood-pewees
5. Bobolink
6. Bats (e.g., Little Brown Myotis and Northern Myotis)

**Other Parks Canada News:**

Campground reservations for the 2024 season in PEI National Park are open. Reservations can be made by calling the Parks Canada Reservation service at 1-877-737-3783, or online at [reservation.pc.gc.ca](http://reservation.pc.gc.ca). PEI National Park campgrounds open June 11<sup>th</sup>.

Green Gables Heritage Place is open for general admission starting May 1<sup>st</sup>. The site is open 7 days a week from 9am-5pm until October 31<sup>st</sup>.

## Community Cupboard Donations

The Community Cupboard at the Dr Roddie Community Center has been in operation for over a year now and is still being used every week. Donation day is Tuesdays from 2 to 5. The cupboard is open Thursdays from 9 am to 8pm and Fridays from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

Some people have asked what we need and basically anything that you buy for yourself at the grocery store can be used in the Cupboard, fridge or freezer.

Some of the more popular items are:

Puddings, wagon wheels, granola bars, goldfish crackers, jello packs, fruit cups (anything for kids lunches goes pretty fast).

Kraft dinner, canned ham, chicken or turkey, tuna, salmon, bread, cereal, cheese, eggs, milk, French fries, frozen dinners, pizza, fruit and meat.

Toiletries are also picked up quickly, Kleenex, toilet paper are also needed.

The residents and local businesses have been generous with their food and monetary donations and it is appreciated. We don't monitor the people coming in to get food but we also don't put everything out at once so we try to ensure that everyone who needs food has a chance to get some.

### Canadian Red Cross Health Equipment Loan Program

The Health Equipment Loan Program (HELP) of the Canadian Red Cross allows people to return home from hospital earlier or recover more safely at home from serious injury, illness or surgery, and gives independence and dignity to those in palliative care.

Individuals can receive short-term loans of mobility and safety devices such as wheelchairs, walkers, bath seats, benches, commodes and toilet seats, crutches and canes, bed handles and other durable medical equipment.

There is no charge for loans but a written referral outlining what items are needed is required from a doctor or other medical professional.

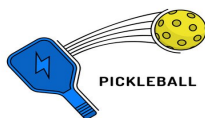

## JIM MacAULAY COMPLEX

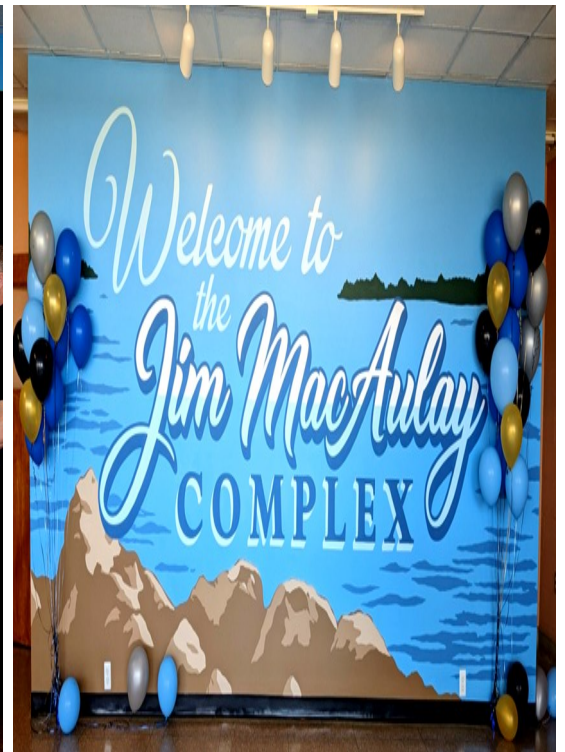

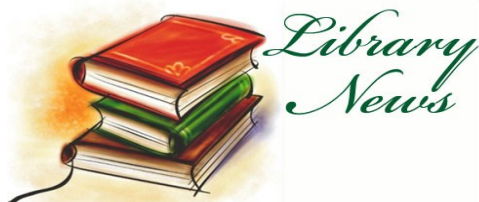
