Domestic animal ban in place on PEI National Park beaches

To provide a safe environment for visitors and to protect wildlife and their habitats, domestic animals are not permitted on the beaches of PEI National Park from April 1 to October 15. The presence of dogs and other domestic animals on beaches can cause disturbance to wildlife, including the endangered Piping Plover.

Dogs are permitted in all other outdoor areas of the park, including trails and campgrounds. Visitors are reminded that all pets must be on a leash at all times (maximum length 3 metres) and owners are required to clean up after their pet.

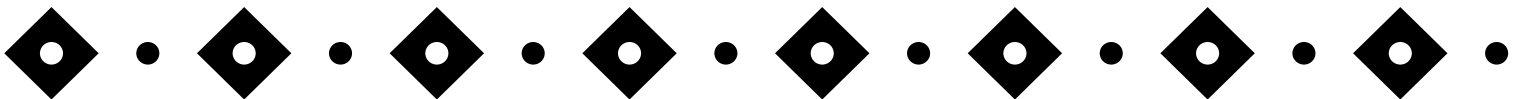
Reservations and early bird season passes

Early bird season passes for PEI National Park will go on sale from April 7th until June 15th at www.parksorders.ca. They will also be available for purchase at Ardgowan National Historic Site in Charlottetown from Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Passes can be purchased at the Greenwich Interpretation Centre when it opens for the season on June 4th.

The cupboard is open Thursdays from 9 am to 8pm and Fridays from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm. Some people have asked what we need and basically anything that you buy for yourself at the grocery store can be used in the Cupboard, fridge or freezer.

Some of the more popular items are:

Puddings, wagon wheels, granola bars, goldfish crackers, jello packs, fruit cups (anything for kids lunches goes pretty fast).

Kraft dinner, canned ham, chicken or turkey, tuna, salmon, bread, cereal, cheese, eggs, milk, French fries, frozen dinners, pizza, fruit and meat.

Canadian Red Cross Health Equipment Loan Program

The Health Equipment Loan Program (HELP) of the Canadian Red Cross allows people to return home from hospital earlier or recover more safely at home from serious injury, illness or surgery, and gives independence and dignity to those in palliative care.

Individuals can receive short-term loans of mobility and safety devices such as wheelchairs, walkers, bath seats, benches, commodes and toilet seats, crutches and canes, bed handles and other durable medical equipment.

There is no charge for loans but a written referral outlining what items are needed is required from a doctor or other medical professional.

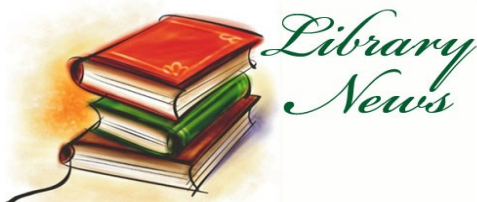
Summer Camp Project

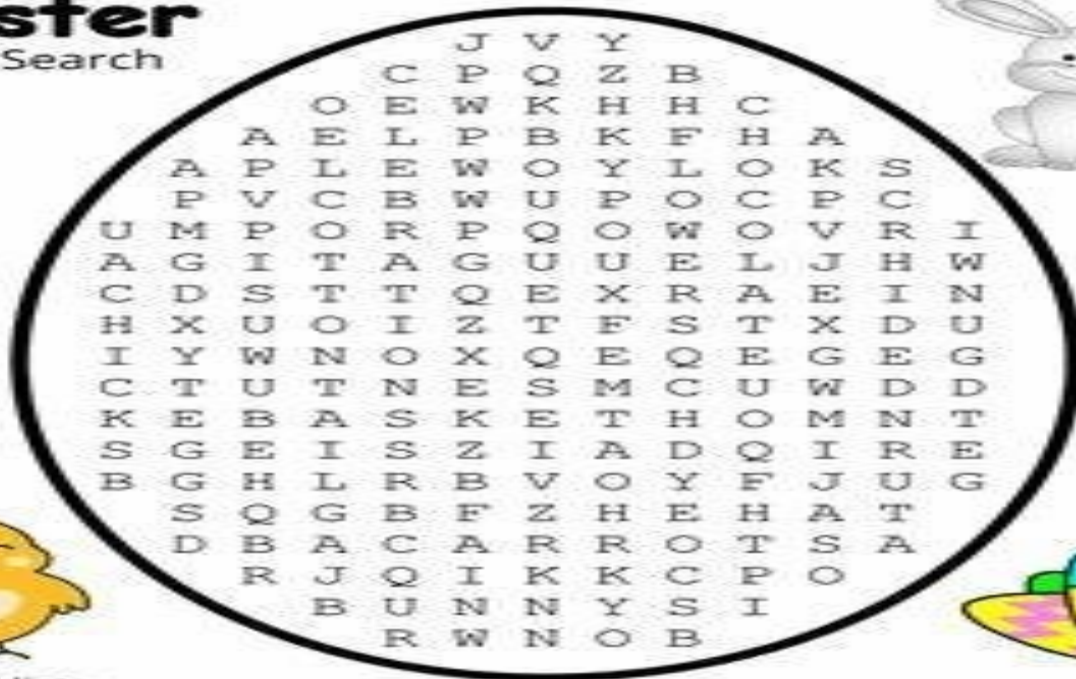

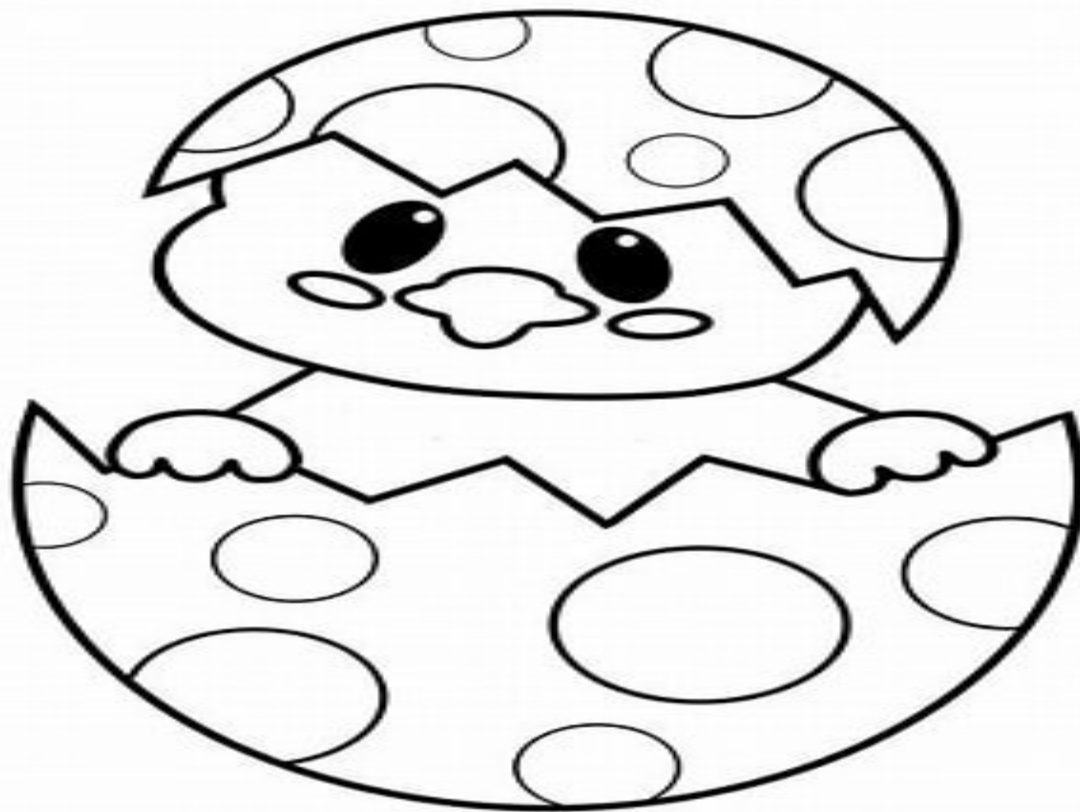

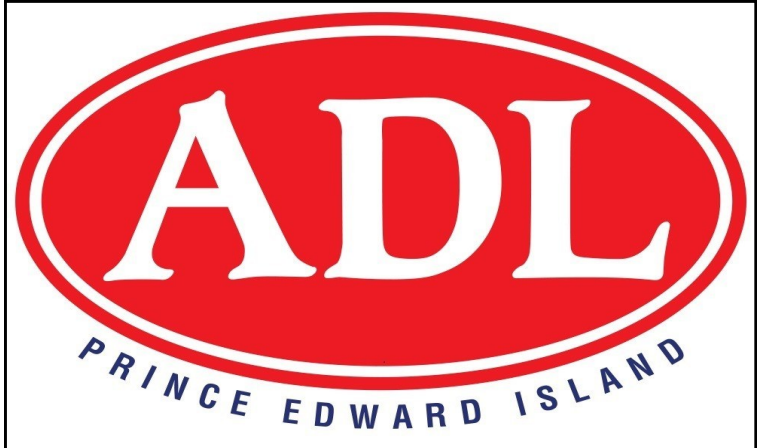
